YASS CLOSING CATALOGUE

The Yass property is now for sale and will be put in the hands of an agent around mid-January.

The reasons are simple. My back is no longer young. The kangaroo problem means the property needs more careful maintenance than I can manage. And the market seems favourable. An enormous number of bulbs, probably hundreds of thousands, of an enormous diversity of narcissus will be passed on to someone else.

I have lifted just a small number of many things, concentrating on groups not previously offered.

The bulbs appear healthy and have not been heat treated.

POETS

Lockdowns meant the Yass property fended for itself unseen and untouched last season. The poets seem to have done well amongst enormous clumps of grass, but they have not been evaluated as I'd hoped and the photos are not always the best. Some are early enough to be passable show flowers in Canberra but they are not as round as the best New Zealand varieties.

Poets are generally late season and prefer climates where springtime is long and cool and wet – about 2 years in 10 at Yass. They are grown in a gully that can get very boggy.

All poets burn in the sun but their scent is divine. They are well worth picking just as they are opening.

The color codes are an approximation. Sometimes 3 letters are not enough.

The variety 'Greenholm' is the K.J. Heazlewood poet 9W-GYO Milan x Moina

'Franks Fancy' was used because it is a 2 headed poet, a characteristic that sometimes appears in its seedlings.

A couple of years ago I started identifying poets suitable for sale, earlier in the season as I recall. I have marked these with a *. It means they looked good in the field at the time.

This group were named because they seemed to be the most garden worthy plants in each of these colors.

Yazquil Angel (01_382 Moomba x jonquilla) 7W-W



Late. 1-2 florets per stem. One of the few sterile jonquil hybrids to set seed.

This has been disappointing in the last couple of years. The bulbs are small and may not flower this coming season. Perhaps they increase too fast and are overcrowded.

STERILE TRIANDRUS HYBRIDS

If you are having trouble growing this group then plant them SHALLOW in soil that has good drainage; and don't be afraid to leave them to dry bake in the ground over summer.

Sun Tiger (00_01MJR Hillstar x triandrus) 5Y-Y



This variety is absurdly vigorous in the field. It copes with bog and drought and because the bulbs are shallow, can sometimes get severely baked.

Like Sun Tiger this variety is also absurdly vigorous in the field. It too copes with bog and drought and, because the bulbs are also shallow, can also be severely baked.

Only a few bulbs have been lifted because they are small – probably overcrowded and over-hopped upon. They may not flower in their first year.

Like the other triandrus hybrids this too likes to be shallow. I am trying to breed flowers that look much more like the species than this. The name is an allusion to Grant Mitsch's 'Akepa'

APODANTHI HYBRIDS

If you are having trouble growing this group then, like the triandrus hybrids, plant them **SHALLOW** in soil with good drainage; and don't be afraid to leave them to dry bake in the ground over summer. Some of these have survived for several years in small black punnets in the sun.

This is a grex of seedlings that for me are the hardest and most vigorous of their type. I am now of the view that they should be the foundation of all breeding in this section. They probably should be inter-crossed to recapture 7W-W (and probably also 7Y-YYW) etc.

The name first appeared in a Drewitt Catalog.

This is an astonishingly vigorous inter-sectional bulbocodium hybrid that has proven itself to be a parent of vigorous seedlings. To my knowledge, this is the first fertile hybrid of its type. It's classification as division 10 is correct I think, but it is NOT a miniature.

This is one of the most remarkable of tazettas. It is one of the very first daffodils to flower in the autumn, flowering within weeks of a cool wet change - and can be forced to flower even earlier by putting it in the shade and watering it. It has scent that may be pleasant even to those who dislike tazettas. It is outstandingly floriferous and an outstanding increaser with almost every offset producing a stem of flowers. It may prove to be one of the few daffodils that succeed on the coast
