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### **THE NOT POETS CATALOG**

Over the years I have tried to make the daffodil collection available to interested growers. This year was meant to be the year for poeticus. They were spread out in 2018, but spring that year was only wet enough for bulbs to not go backwards. Spring 2019 saw hardly any rain at all. Many flowers blasted and the bulbs have deteriorated. They are unlikely to flower this year and may not be suitable for next year's catalog even if there is a perfect season. This picture was taken on the 15<sup>th</sup> of September, the weekend of the Canberra show.

And then there were a couple of months of smoke in Canberra, which meant that lifting was difficult – so apologies for a very modest catalog this year.

## DEEP BULBOCODIUMS

This year a collection of bulbocodiums that like to be planted deep is being offered. These might be worth trying in climates where other daffodils struggle. They are hardy here but they don't increase as quickly as some other varieties. Only a few bulbs are available. In Canberra in light sandy soil the baseplate sits about 9cm below the surface.

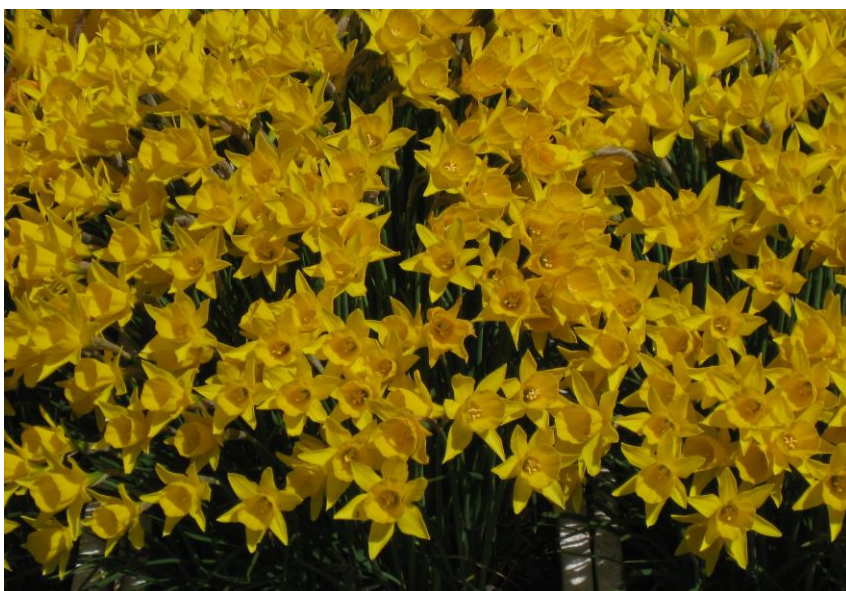

## INTERSECTIONAL BULBOCODIUM HYBRIDS

Gold Step Alfriston x bulbocodium 10Y-Y



This is an astonishingly vigorous inter-sectional bulbocodium hybrid that has proven itself to be a parent of vigorous seedlings. Its classification as division 10 is correct I think ( by comparison traditional division 5's do not look like triandrus). It is a small daffodil but is NOT technically a miniature.

## TAZETTAS

### First Stanza (N. elegans x Soleil D'Or) 8W-O



This is one of the most remarkable of all tazettas. It is one of the very first daffodils to flower in the autumn, flowering within weeks of a cool wet change - and can be forced to flower even earlier by putting it in the shade and watering it. It has scent that may be pleasant even to those who dislike tazettas. It is outstandingly floriferous and an outstanding increaser with almost every offset producing a stem of flowers. It may prove to be one of the very few daffodils that succeed on the coast. It is fully fertile for those interested in daffodil breeding.

### 07\_02T (N. tazetta subsp. laticolor x N. elegans) miniature 8W-O



This is an Autumn Surprise sibling. It is an autumn flowering miniature that does best if it is grown in the same way as N.elegans:- dry baked over summer with plenty of water and sun in the growing season.
